Subject matter: We would to see illustration art for books, advertising, magazine stories, anything that is created to illustrate something in particular.

Only images transferred to CD in J-peg format will be accepted for jurying. Please clearly label CD's with your artist contact information. Limit of 5 pieces per individual. Entry fee is \$25.00 for 3 works, \$10 for each subsequent entry. Checks should be made out to the Clymer Museum of Art. We prefer to offer works for sale, but acknowledge that some may not be. If accepted, all works must be framed and ready to hang.

Accepted works will need to arrive at the museum by Tuesday, May 27th. Title, price, and insurance information must accompany each piece. The price should reflect a 35% commission to the museum. Please, no oversized pieces. All artwork is insured while on the premises, but we cannot be responsible for insurance on transportation. We are a non-profit museum and cannot pay return shipping costs.

Opening reception for the exhibition is June 6th at 5:00PM. Awards will be given at that time. This show is to be held in conjunction with an exhibit of legendary illustrator/artist **JOHN FORD CLYMER'S** illustration work.

All works must be picked up or shipping arrangements in place by July 27th.
